With a Second Year Group I have created a league table for the One Pen One Dice game. I can track students' scores for each assessment and use Excel to collate the data. I can link this to a reward system.

- Using Microsoft Forms: Data is <u>easily</u> accessed on a given quiz and can then be exported to Microsoft Excel.
- Gradebooks can then be used to access the data and analyse it in more depth (link to summative assessment...)
