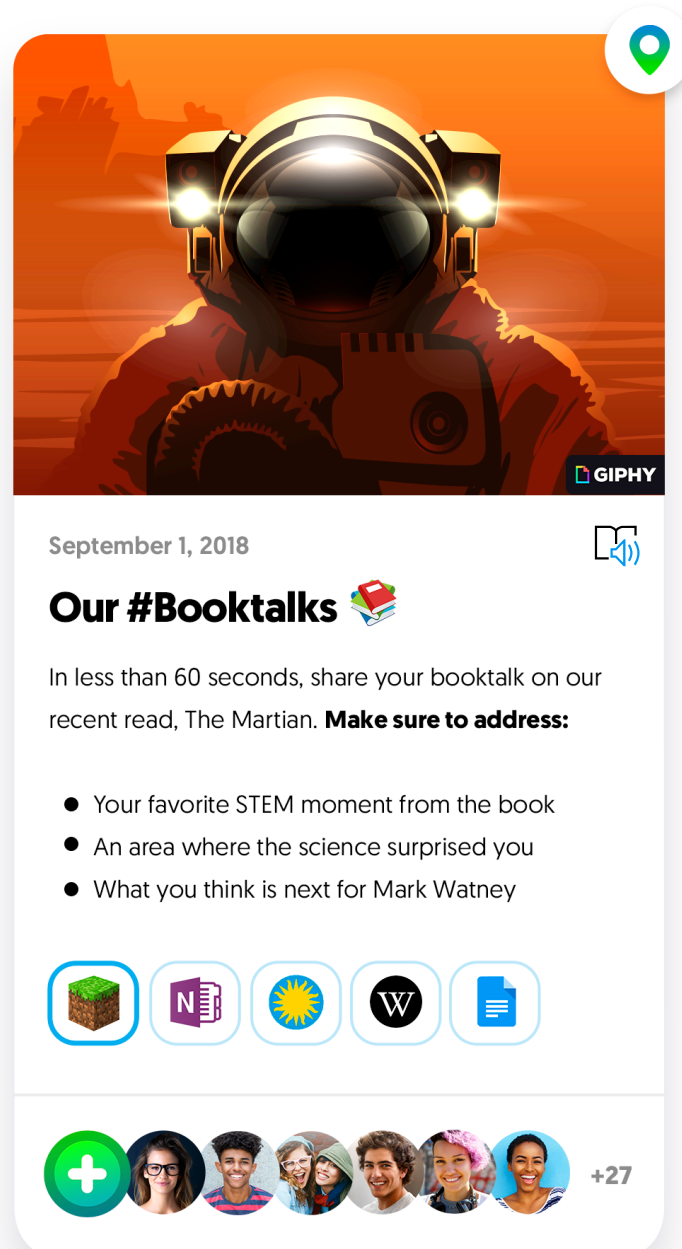




Create a Grid

staff, school, or anyone!

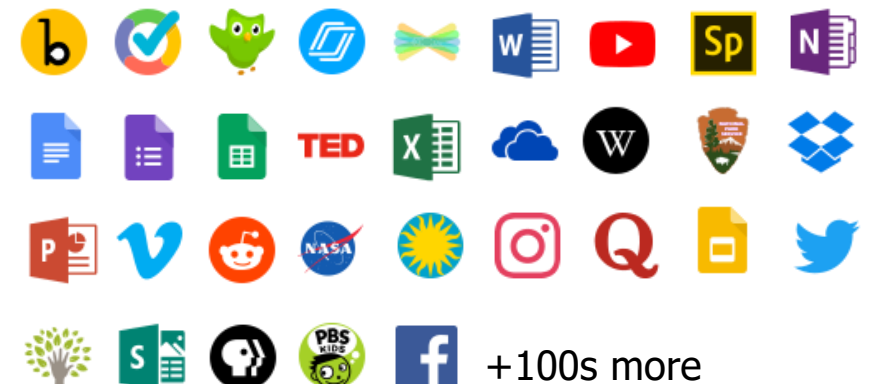
Grid = Classroom

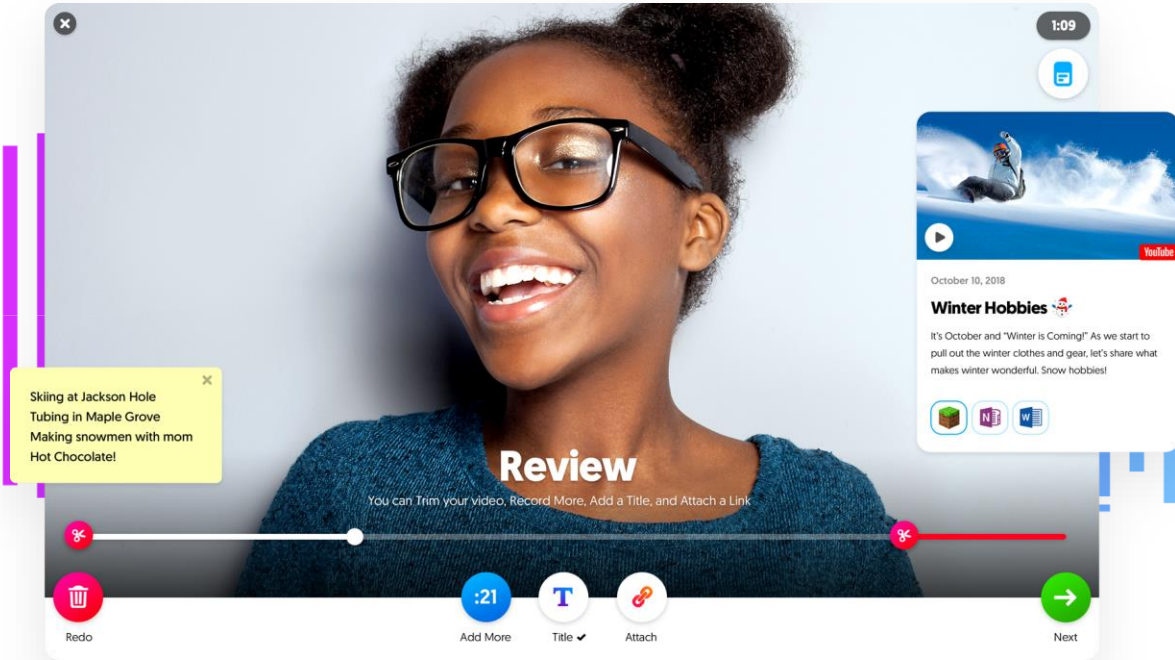
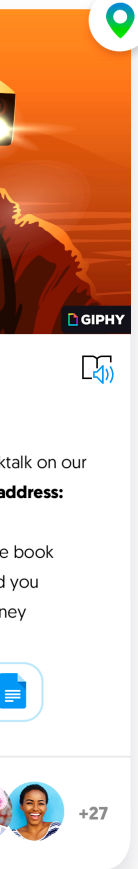


Add Topics

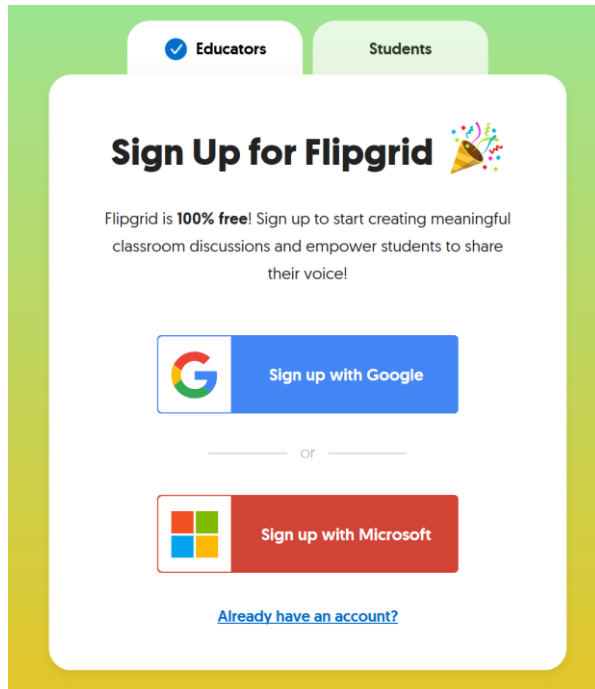

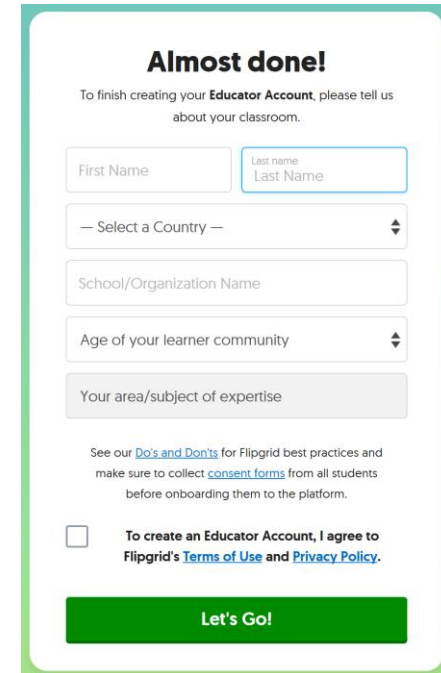

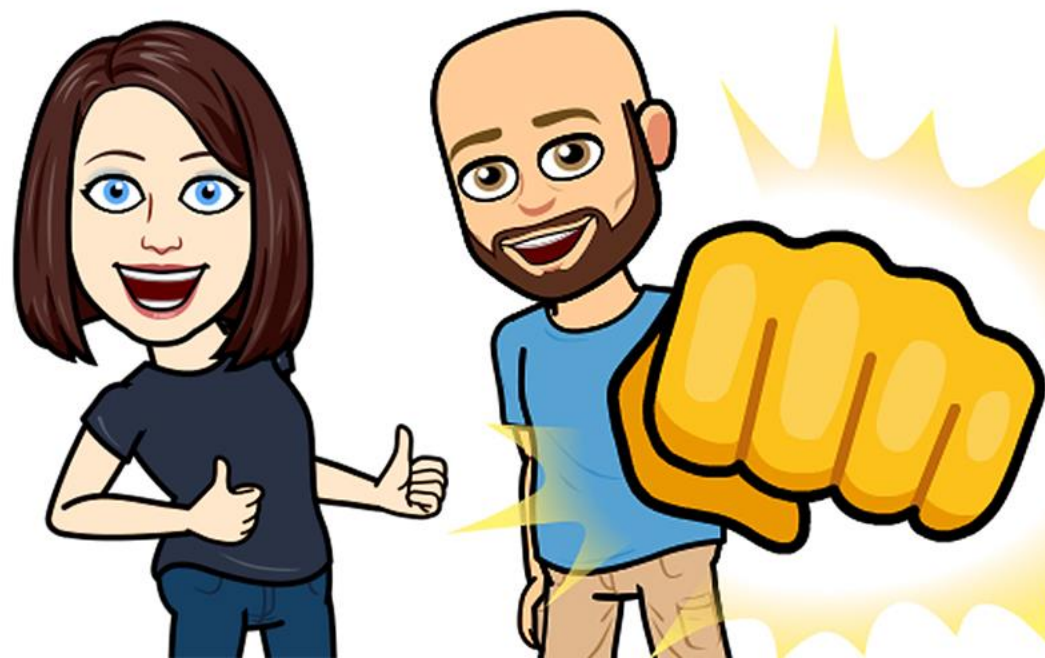
