## Peer and Group Reflection 'in the cloud' (Google Classroom)

The purpose of this activity is to use your VLE to allow students to share the resources they create with their peers (e.g. Google Slides, Image, Google Doc, etc.), give feedback and act on that feedback all 'in the cloud'.

### What are the aims of the project?

- To build resilience through the sharing of resources that they create.
- To encourage students to use peer assessment and to provide 'live' feedback on strengths of a piece of work and areas for improvement.
- To be (as a teacher) a facilitator that activates students as learning resources for one another
- To create new resources (with feedback) that can be stored on VLE and accessed by students later, contributing to an online repository of learning.

### How did you plan for it? How did you organise it?

Students set up a peer assessment section in their notebooks with title of work, date, successes of piece and items to revise.

Title of Assignment	Date	Successes	Feedback provided by...
Family vocabulary	1st April	Used all vocabulary from class and added more words from dictionary.	Luke

Teacher assigns work for students to complete and submit to classroom workspace on VLE. Teacher divides the class into pairs or smaller groups to look at students work and provide feedback on the work in the students notebooks and on the VLE under their assignment submission. ## How was the project successful?

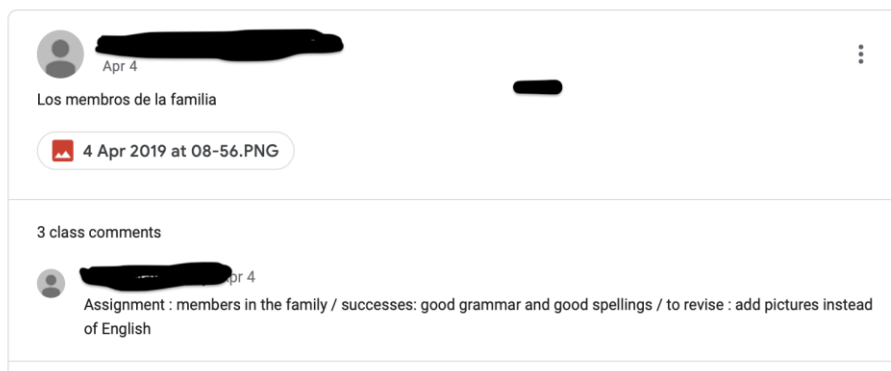
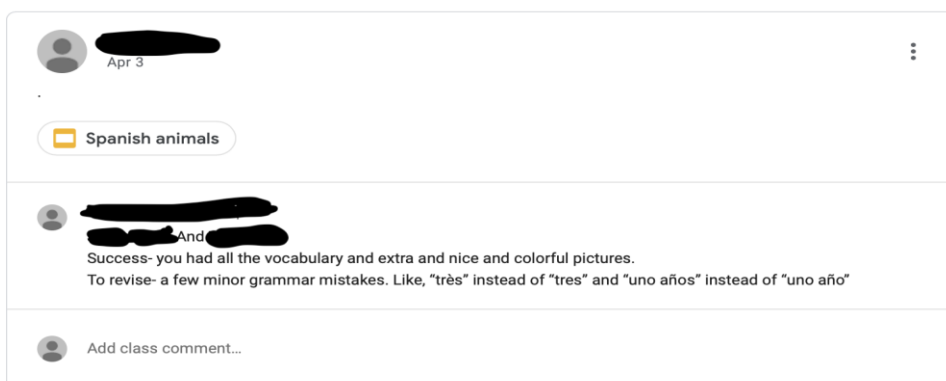
Students are becoming more comfortable with sharing their work with the class. This is motivating students to complete work to a good standard as their classmates will be correcting. Also, they know that they are providing a lasting resource to their classmates' learning that can be used for future revision.

## Why would you recommend this project to other schools?

This strategy provides evidence of student learning, using technology creatively, peer feedback, student reflection, and peer learning. It also documents their learning and feedback in a systematic way.
