Task: Ordering Food

Topic Overview

This topic should enable students to recognise the culture surrounding Korean food and learn some useful phrases related to Korean restaurants. Students will learn vocabulary related to Korean food and describe how something tastes. While doing this, they will be able to understand and reflect on the unique characteristics of Korean cuisine.

Task Description

Students work in small groups to prepare and deliver a simple role play in a restaurant. Students have to describe the taste of the food they ordered.

- Order from a menu
- Describe the taste of something in Korean
- Recognise the names of some types of food
