Task 1: Class Survey About Hobbies



Topic Overview

In this topic, students will learn to use some very basic phrases to talk about others as well as ask and answer questions about personal details. Students may take material that is relevant to their lives and/or from a wider pool of information provided.

Task Description

This task is for students to carry out a class survey and find out what the most common hobbies in the class are. Students can do this in small groups and then report their findings back to the class.

Learning Outcomes

- Recall and pronounce new words for hobbies and the numbers 1-20
- Ask someone about their hobbies
- Tell someone about your hobbies
- Present the results of a simple survey

Observations for teachers

other. Students may wish to include different hobbies than the ones from the presentation on their survey. This can be facilitated by the students finding the keywords in the dictionary and the teacher helping them to form these into a sentence.
