### Leaving Cert Language Classes

For the school year 2021/22 PPLI will be offering Leaving Certificate classes in Mandarin Chinese, Japanese, Lithuanian. Romanian. Polish. Portuguese and Russian. They will run various locations. subiect to at demand. Classes, which are free, are held on Saturdays during school term time. We also offer an online essay writing support for students of noncurricular Romanian language for the Leaving Certificate.



PPLI. together with Cavan and Monaghan Education and Training Board and H2 Learning, introduced a taster blended learning project in March 2021 for Polish, with a full course in the Senior Cycle being implemented from September. Some classes will be online, some face to face. A blended learning pilot of Saturday LC Chinese and Portuguese classes has also begun with two groups of 5th Year students from across the country.
