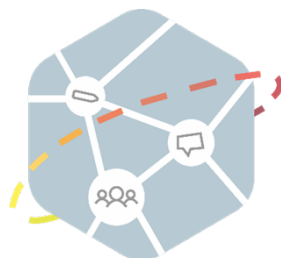

Workshops should clearly state the target audience, intended outcome/ application, and indicate how participants will be actively engaged for the duration of the workshop.

Posters should clearly set out the context and significance of the proposed contribution.
