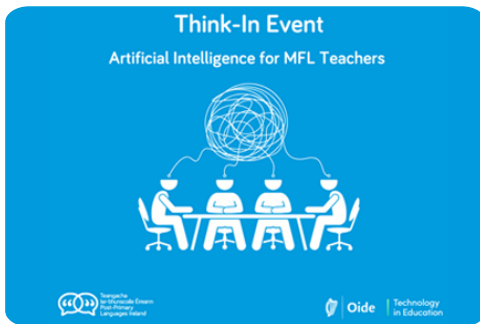

PPLI Associate Recruitment



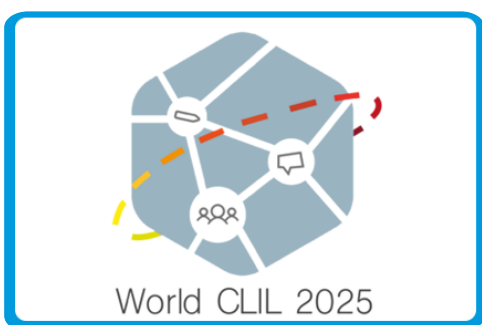
