Post-Primary Languages Ireland (PPLI), a unit of the Department of Education and Youth, plays a key role in supporting the teaching and learning aspect of the FLA programme and our team is very much looking forward to meeting you soon.

#### **Annual Induction**

#### Optional online pre-arrival support sessions

We invite you to attend one of our **pre-arrival online support sessions** for FLAs. These sessions will run on **Zoom** at **7:30pm (GMT)** across a series of **evening dates** in September and may assist you with queries to facilitate your initial arrival at your host school. Unlike induction, for which attendance is mandatory, these sessions are offered as optional events.

These events are intended for FLAs only; similar sessions were provided for your cooperating teachers in May 2025.

9, 10 and 11 September 2025 at 7:30pm (GMT)	Online Pre-arrival Support Sessions for FLAs (optional)  These sessions are optional and aim to support you as you plan your arrival to Ireland.
2 October 2025	FLA Induction, Hotel Riu Plaza The Gresham, 23 O'Connell Street Upper, Dublin, D01 C3W7 This event aims to support you as an FLA shortly after your arrival at your host school. Attendance at induction is mandatory.
13-23 October 2025	Support Session for Cooperating Teachers (CTs) and FLAs You will be notified of registration for this in September. These support sessions are held in person, at venues nationwide, in October. A selection of dates and venues are available, and you will attend on one evening of your choice with your cooperating teacher(s).
2-3 December 2025	FLA Community of Practice (CoP)  We offer dedicated online CoPs for FLAs. These CoPs are meetings for FLAs to come together to share good practice, create new knowledge, and exchange ideas. The activities depend on the participants and are based on mutual respect and trust, which encourages a willingness to share ideas, expose one's knowledge gaps, ask questions, and listen to others. These sessions take place online during the evenings.
19-21 January 2026	Thematic Communities of Practice (CoP) You will be notified of registration for these optional online events in December and the sessions are held in January. For these CoPs, you may attend with your cooperating teacher(s).

#### **PPLI Link Associates**

PPLI Link Associates are a network of experienced teaching professionals located across Ireland. You will be linked to a specific associate, and they will be available to you throughout the school year to assist with any teaching and learning queries you may have. Your Link Associate will also 'check in' with you at designated intervals to see how you are getting on and to offer any advice or support you may need.

Training for all teachers/tutors will be provided by PPLI.
